The technical assignment this week is to select two (or three) images to combine into one composition.

To begin:

1. Use [Creative Commons](#) to locate two (or three) images of your choosing.
2. Determine which image will be the main canvas and which image will be the secondary canvas. The secondary canvas is the image you will crop/select a portion to paste onto the main canvas image.
3. Using the concepts discussed in this week's lectures (e.g. resize, crop, selection tools) crop/select a portion of the secondary canvas and paste this selection onto the main canvas image. In order to successfully meet the objectives of this assignment, you must use at least two tools within GIMP. Note: The new image cannot exceed a maximum 400 pixels wide (whatever height works for your image).
4. Save your new image as firstnameinitial_lastname_ta2.png (e.g., r_rucker_ta2.png)

Submission Requirements:

- Post your two (or three) original images and new image to this discussion board.
- Briefly summarize the steps and tools you used to create your new image.
- Comment on at least two classmates' new image. Within your comment, point out what you liked about the new image and one suggestion on improvement (remember to be professional).
